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# INTRODUCTION

## Scope and Purpose of Report

As required by Section 240.118, Florida Statutes, this report provides feedback to districts and high schools on their graduates' performance on entry-level placement tests at Florida public community colleges and universities. Every freshman in a public community college or university in Florida must demonstrate certain basic skills before beginning college-level courses. Students who achieve minimum scores on the Elementary Algebra, Reading Comprehension, and Sentence Skills portions of the Florida College Placement Test (CPT) are considered "ready" for college-level math, reading, and writing, respectively. Students may be exempted from these tests if they score high enough on the SAT or ACT. Freshmen who do not achieve minimum scores on the CPT, SAT or ACT must take remedial classes before they begin college-level work.

This report includes students who:

- graduated during the 1998-99 school year with a standard diploma from a Florida public high school,
- and*
- entered a Florida public university or community college as degree-seeking students in 1999-2000.

These students represent about half of the 1998-99 class of public high school graduates. The report **does not include:**

- graduates who do not go to college,
- graduates who attend private or out-of-state colleges,
- transfer students,
- casual or non-degree-seeking students,
- students who take time off between high school and college,
- GED or non-standard diploma recipients, and
- private high school graduates.

## History of the Placement Testing and Feedback Program

The current report is the second in which the same passing scores on the Florida College Placement Test applied to all students statewide. In the first years of the statewide testing program, colleges used different tests and different passing scores. In next year's report, the exemption scores required on the SAT or ACT will change again. **As a consequence, readers should use caution in interpreting differences in the results from one report year to the next.**

Following is a brief timeline of the development of the statewide placement test and feedback program:

- 1983 — Legislature establishes common placement testing program
- 1990 — Feedback report to high schools begins
- 1995 — Florida College Placement Test introduced at some colleges
- 1996 — Florida College Placement Test required at all colleges
- 1996 — Placement test cutoff scores raised at many colleges
- 1997 — Placement test cutoff scores raised at remaining colleges, becoming uniform across state in July 1997
- 2000 — First feedback to districts and high schools based on uniform statewide Florida College Placement Test cutoff scores
- 2000 — Starting in fall 2000, increase in ACT and SAT scores required for exemption

## Current Remedial Cutoff Scores

For students taking the Florida College Placement Test in 1999-2000, the cutoff scores for placement into college-level courses were:

Elementary Algebra	72
Reading Comprehension	83
Sentence Skills	83

Colleges did not have to give the CPT to students who scored at or above the following scores on college admissions tests:

### SAT-I, The College Board

Verbal	420 (counts for both Reading and Sentence Skills)
Math	440

### Enhanced ACT, American College Testing Program

Reading	16
English	16
Math	16

Although they are not required to do so, some colleges may also have given the College Placement Tests to certain students with scores above these levels.

**NOTE: Starting with the fall 2000 semester, the SAT and ACT scores required to be exempt from taking the CPT changed to:**

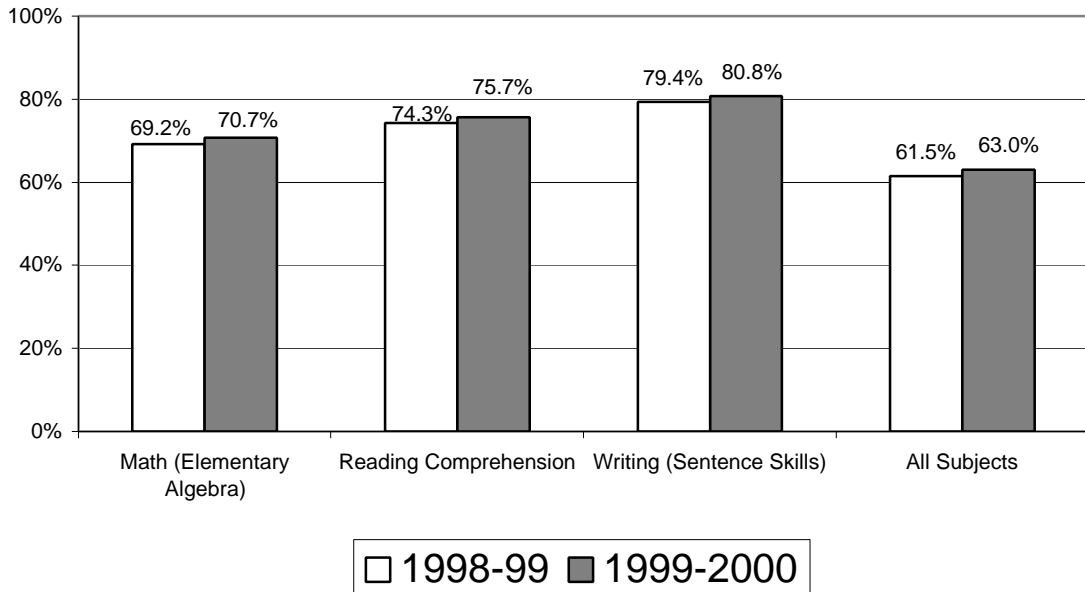
## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- Of the 99,027 recipients of standard diplomas in Florida public high schools in 1998-99, 51,081, or 51.6%, enrolled as degree-seeking students at a Florida public university or community college during the 1999-2000 academic year. Of these, 30,013, or 30.3% of standard diploma graduates, were enrolled in a community college and 21,068, or 21.3% of graduates, were enrolled in a state university. By comparison, in last year's report, 49.6% of 1997-98 graduates were reported to have enrolled in public postsecondary institutions in 1998-99, with 29.8% enrolling in community colleges and 19.8% in state universities.
- Of the 51,081 degree-seeking students, complete test results in reading, writing and math were reported for 49,804, or about 97.5%.
- Of the graduates who enrolled as degree-seeking students, 31,393 or 63% were considered "ready" in all three subject areas, compared with 61.5% in 1998-99. This means that 18,411, or 37%, needed remedial classes in one or more areas, compared with 38.5% in 1998-99
- As in previous years, fewer test-takers were considered "ready" in math than in reading or writing. There were 70.7% "ready" in math, compared with 69.2% in 1998-99; 75.7% were "ready" in reading, compared with 74.3% in 1998-99; and 80.8% were "ready" in writing, compared with 79.4% in 1998-99.\*
- There were 42.5% of black students "ready" in all three areas, compared with 40.3% in 1998-99; 49.9% of Hispanic students were ready in all areas, compared with 44.9% in 1998-99; 69.7% of Asian students were ready, compared with 69.4% in 1998-99; 63.6% of American Indian students were ready, compared with 55% in 1998-99; and 71.3% of white students were ready, compared with 70.4% in 1998-99.
- There were 64% of men ready in all three areas, compared with 62.3% of women (1998-99 percentages were 62.9% and 60.4%, respectively). Women, however, were more likely to pass the writing test than men.

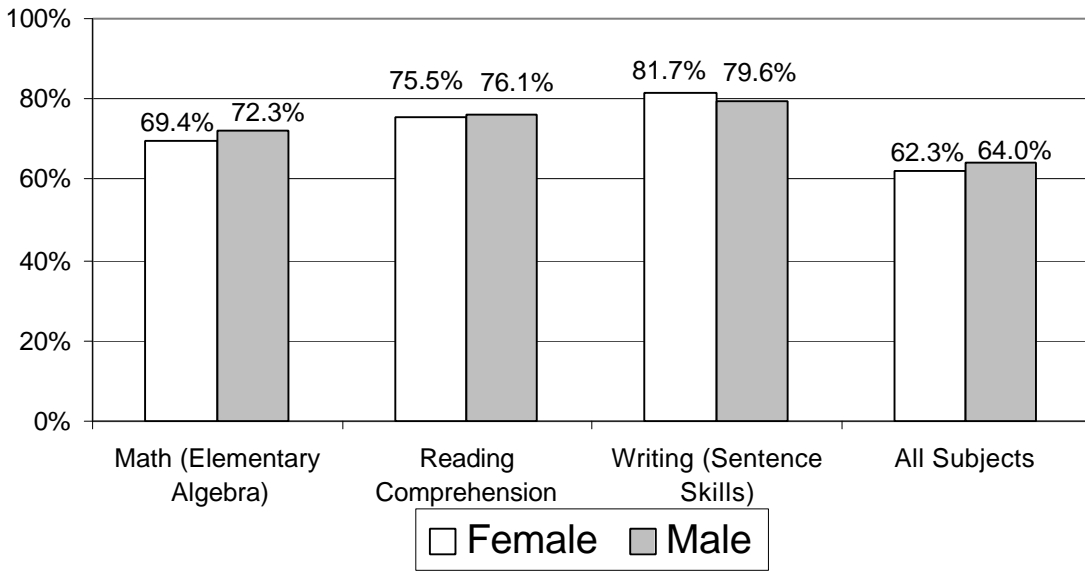
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\*Note: After last year's report was published, the State University System reported 266 additional 1997-98 graduates who needed remediation in math and 699 additional graduates who needed remediation in writing in 1998-99. This accounts for the change from the figures initially printed in last year's report, which were 69.7% ready statewide in math and 80.9% ready statewide in writing.

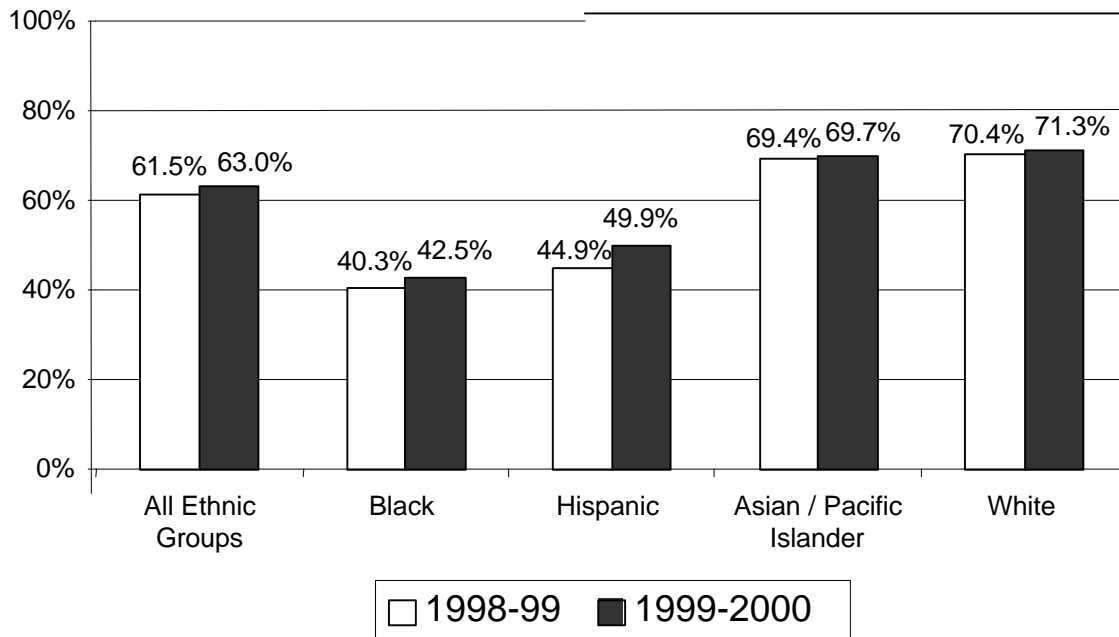
## PERCENT TESTED "READY" STATEWIDE BY SUBJECT AREA



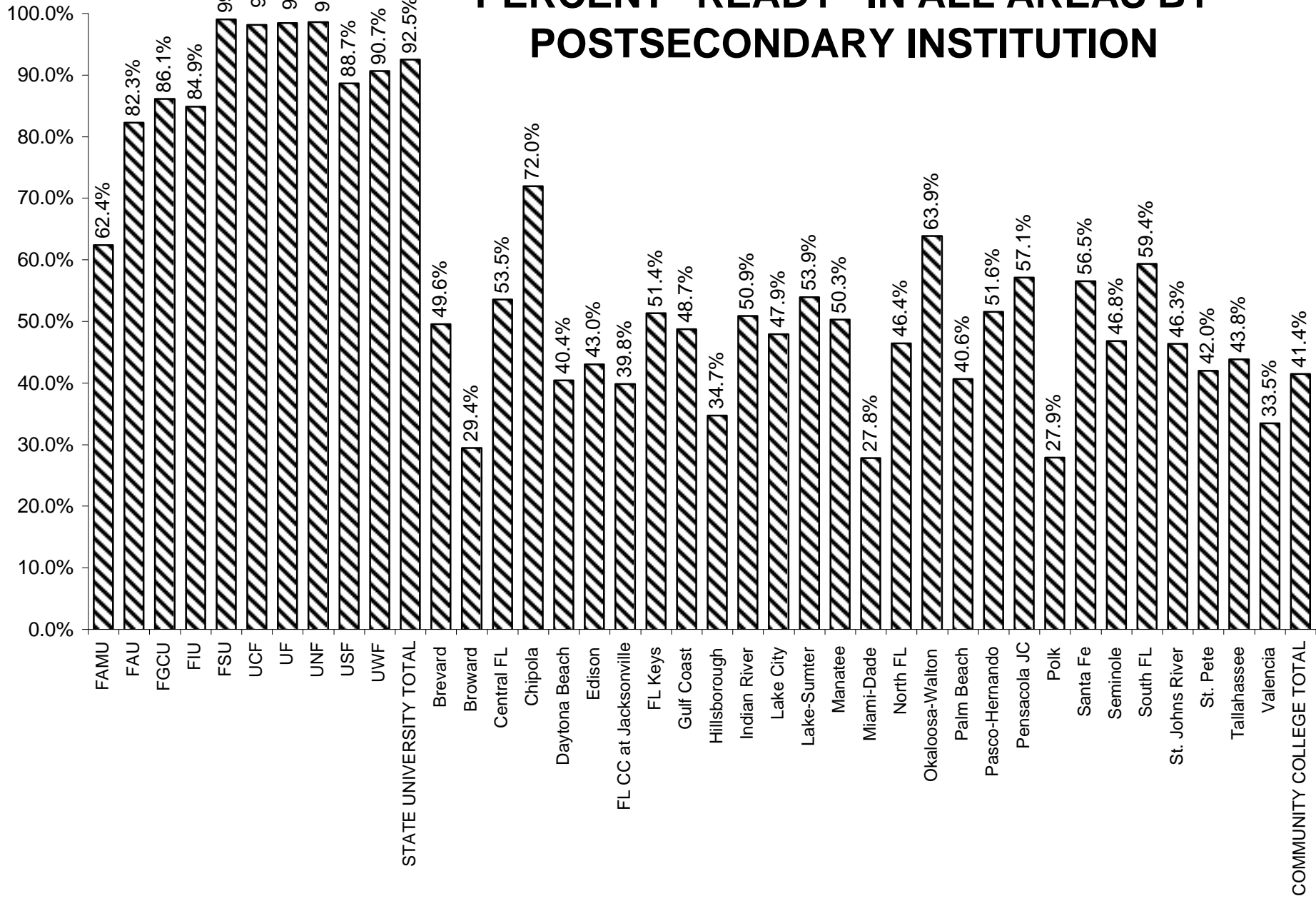
## PERCENT TESTED "READY" BY SUBJECT AREA AND GENDER
