# INTRODUCTION

## Scope and Purpose of Report

As required by section 240.118, Florida Statutes, this report provides feedback to districts and high schools on their graduates' performance on entry-level placement tests at Florida public community colleges and universities. Every freshman in a public community college or university in Florida must demonstrate certain basic skills before beginning college-level courses. Students who achieve minimum scores on the Elementary Algebra, Reading Comprehension, and Sentence Skills portions of the Florida College Placement Test (CPT) are considered "ready" for college-level math, reading, and writing respectively. Students may be exempted from these tests if they score high enough on the SAT or ACT. Freshmen who do not score high enough on the CPT, SAT or ACT must take remedial classes before they begin college-level work.

This year's report includes students who

- graduated during the 1997-98 school year from a Florida public high school, *and*
- entered a Florida public university or community college as degree-seeking students in 1998-99.

These students represent about half of the 1997-98 class of public high school graduates. The report **does not include:**

- graduates who do not go to college;
- graduates who attend private or out-of-state colleges;
- transfer students;
- casual or non-degree-seeking students;
- graduates who take time off between high school and college;
- GED, certificate, or special diploma recipients; or
- private high school graduates.

## History of the Placement Testing and Feedback Program

The current report is the first in which the same passing scores on the Florida College Placement Test applied to all students statewide. In the first years of the statewide testing program, colleges used different tests and different passing scores. **As a consequence, readers should use caution in interpreting differences in the results from one report year to the next.**

Following is a brief timeline of the development of the statewide placement test and feedback program:

- 1983 — Legislature establishes common placement testing program.
- 1990 — Feedback report to high schools begins.
- 1995 — Florida College Placement Test introduced at some colleges.
- 1996 — Florida College Placement Test required at all colleges.
- 1996 — Placement test cutoff scores raised at many colleges.
- 1997 — Placement test cutoff scores raised at remaining colleges, becoming uniform across state in July, 1997.
- 2000 — First feedback to districts and high schools based on uniform statewide Florida College Placement Test cutoff scores.

## **Current Remedial Cutoff Scores**

For students who took the Florida College Placement Test in 1998-99, the cutoff scores for placement into college-level courses were:

Elementary Algebra	72
Reading Comprehension	83
Sentence Skills	83

Colleges did not have to give the CPT to students who scored at or above the following scores on college admissions tests:

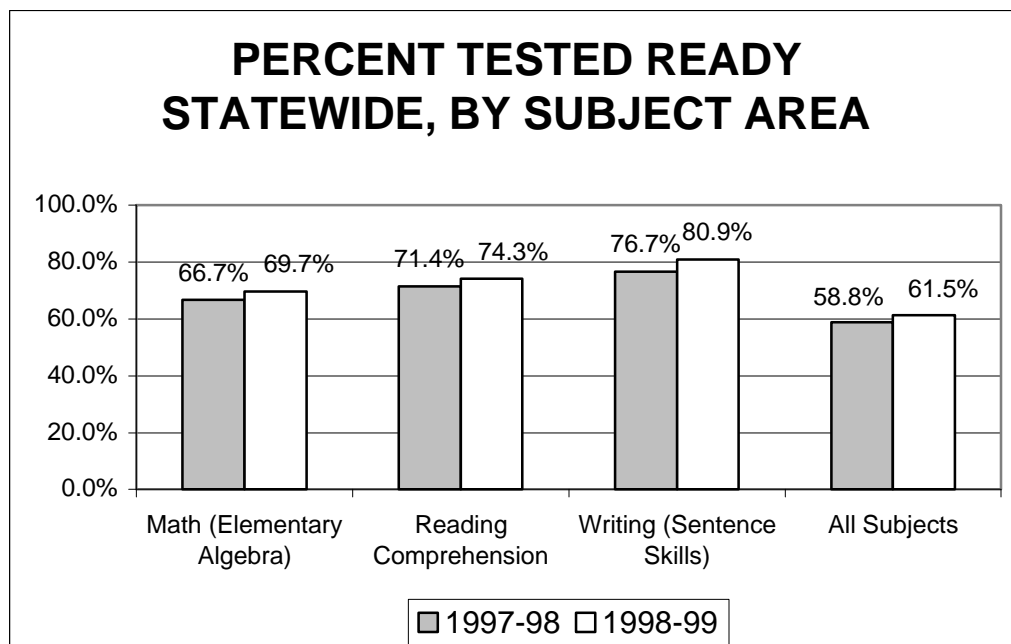

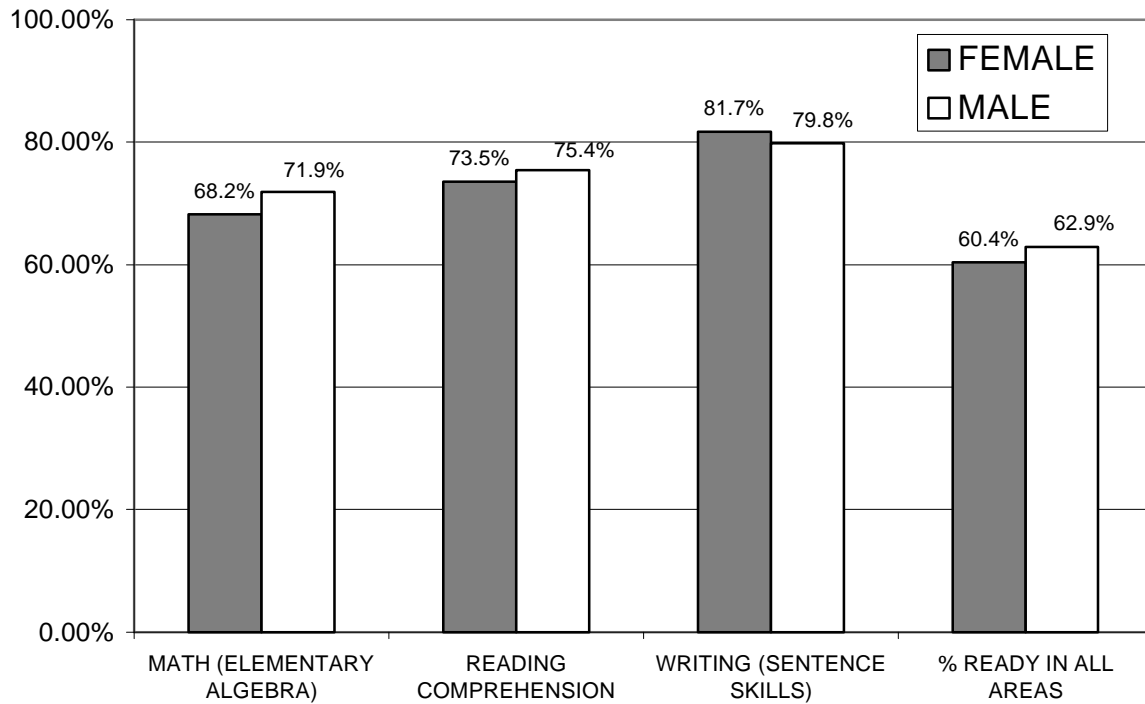
Although they are not required to do so, some colleges may also have given the College Placement Tests to certain students with scores above these levels.

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

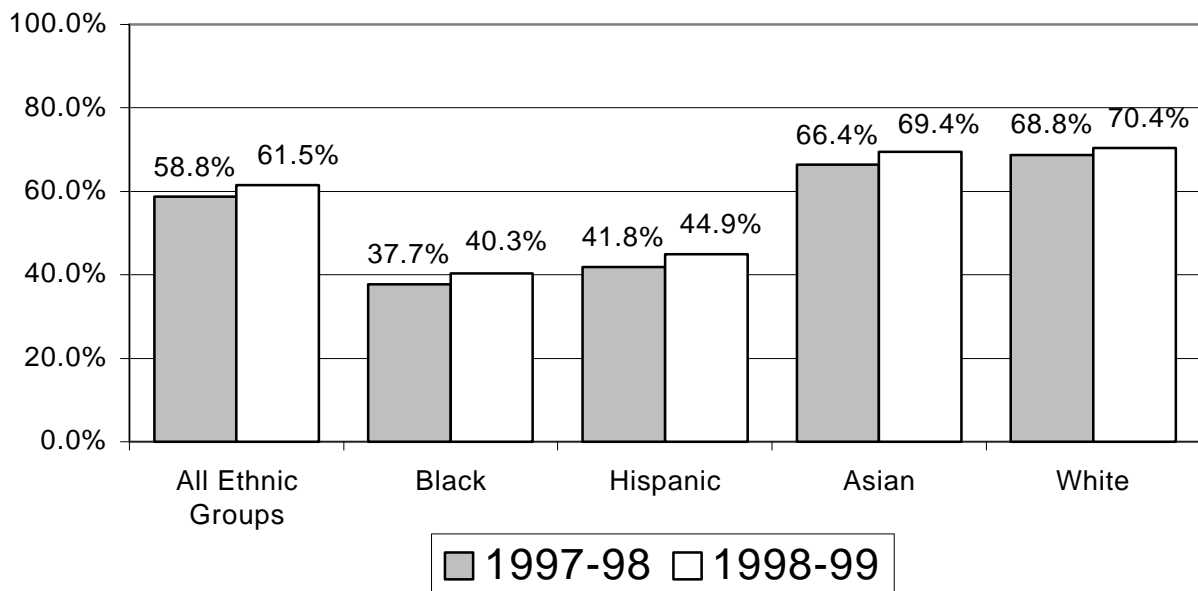
- Of the 95,989 recipients of standard diplomas in Florida public high schools in 1997-98, 47,578, or 49.6%, enrolled as degree-seeking students at a Florida public university or community college during the 1998-99 academic year. 28,572, or 29.8%, were enrolled in a community college and 19,006, or 19.8% were enrolled in a state university. By comparison, in the prior year's report, 49.5% of 1996-97 graduates were reported to have enrolled in public postsecondary institutions in 1997-98, with 32.2% enrolling in community colleges and 17.2% in state universities.
- Of the 47,578 degree-seeking students, complete test results in reading, writing and math were reported for 46,009, or about 97%. Complete records were available for only 94% of degree-seeking students in 1997-98. Some of the changes in the current year's report may be attributable to improved data collection.
- Of the graduates who enrolled as degree-seeking students, 28,280 or 61.5% were considered "ready" in all three subject areas, compared with 58.8% in 1997-98. 17,729, or 38.5%, needed remedial classes in one or more areas, compared with 41.2% in 1997-98.
- As in previous years, fewer test-takers were considered "ready" in math than in reading or writing. 69.7% were "ready" in math, compared with 66.7% in 1997-98; 74.3% were "ready" in reading, compared with 71.4% in 1997-98; and 80.9% were "ready" in writing, compared with 76.7% in 1997-98.
- 40.3% of black students were ready in all three areas, compared with 37.7% in 1997-98; 44.9% of hispanic students were ready in all areas, compared with 41.8% in 1997-98; 69.4% of asian students were ready, compared with 66.4% in 1997-98; 55% of American Indian students were ready, compared with 61.8% in 1997-98; and 70.4% of white students were ready, compared with 68.8% in 1997-98.
- 62.9% of men were ready in all three areas, compared with 60.4% of women (1997-98 percentages were 60.2% and 57.8% respectively). Women, however, performed better on the writing test than men.



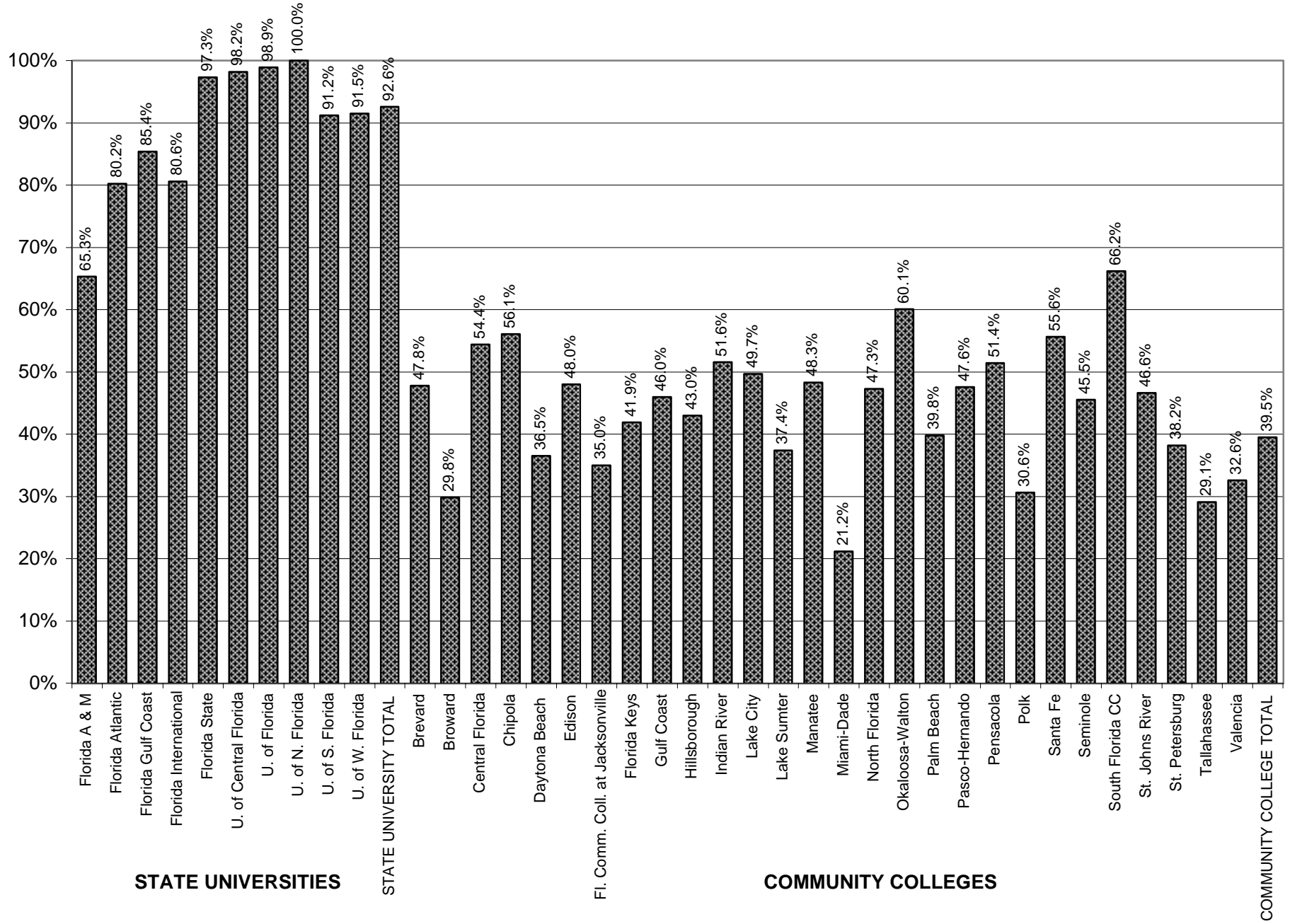
### PERCENT TESTED "READY" BY SUBJECT AREA AND GENDER
